### Fixed Issues

1	549	<p>If SQL Server is used, then the Good Share Server service account must read/write access to the database.</p> <p>If the SQL Server database is used, the Good Share Server service accounts must be a Windows user that has read/write access to the SQL Server database.</p> <p>If the SQL Server is installed on the Good Share Server, then the logged in user must have access to the database to run the Good Share console. If the SQL Server is installed on a remote server, the service account must be changed to an account that has read/write access to the SQL Server database.</p>	<p>Run &gt; "Services.msc".</p> <p>Right click "Good Share Server Service" service and click properties.</p> <p>Go to "Log On" tab &gt; Select "This account" radio button and enter a windows account that has read/write access to the SQL Server Database, then click <b>OK</b>.</p>
